These sessions will include presentations from Ms. Lisa McFarland, Division A Governor, speaking on "Using Social Networking to Build Clubs and Membership", and Anita Lewendowski-Brownll speaking on "Using Humor and Storytelling in Speeches". A panel discussion will be led by Gene Deyoe on "Club Rescue" and the sessions will conclude with a talk by Bill Cassell on "Motivation and Inspiration". Bill has won the District International Speech Contest five times and has been awarded more than 40 awards from Toastmasters International. A former corporate trainer for First Data Corp. and US West Communications and a teacher at Southeast Community college this outstanding professional speaker is guaranteed to motivate and inspire.

Both the Tall Tales and the Humorous Speech Contests will also be held during the conference. I always like to learn from listening to those Toastmasters skilled enough to reach the District finals.

Her experience left her enthused, invigorated and rewarded. Her speaking talents were noticed by the speech judges who placed her in the top 27 contestants of the 81 who competed.

Her experience came about as a result of winning the District 24 International Speech Contest and competing at the recent convention in Palm Desert, California this past month, August 11 -14.

This was a new experience for a local Nebraska girl who grew up in Gretna, Nebraska. Neither her degree in liberal arts from UNL, nor her two years as a member of her On Time Delivery TM Club at Werner Enterprises TM Club, prepared her for this challenge.

Her goal in competing was never about winning. She focused on improving her public speaking skills and becoming a better communicator. Amy learned that the secret for success was focusing on "telling her story" and this kept her from being nervous during her speech.

A funny story she told me was about the overall winner of the contest, David Henderson, of Texas. Turns out it was him practicing his speech in the next motel room that Amy and her husband mistook for domestic violence and almost called security. She later told Mr. Henderson about hearing him practice and he was so apologetic and promised to make it up to her. Perhaps he will accept an invitation by Amy on behalf of the District to visit us at one of our upcoming district conferences. Good job Amy.

MEET THE INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENT, TOASTMASTERS INTERNATIONAL BY FLOY WESTERMEIER

Pat Johnson is an ordinary Toastmaster who, in the words of District 24 International Speech Contest winner Amy Holmes, does extraordinary things. She began her career just as you and I did – with an ice breaker speech, but Pat went on to fulfill leadership roles in her Club, her District, and at International level. To become President of Toastmasters International, one must go through the District Chairs (what we call the Trio), serve two years on the Board of Directors for Toastmasters, and then convince some 80 clubs plus International leaders (Past Presidents and International Directors, etc.) to vote for you. When Pat ran for International Office, she sought the office of Third Vice President and then served in each ensuing office until this year when she became International President. Upon her election to Third Vice President, she became the fifth woman to be slated to become the International President (it is normally an automatic progression) in the 86-year history of Toastmasters. Women were not admitted to Toastmasters until 1973! They belonged to a Toastmistress Group prior to that.

Coming from the Canadian prairies, Pat will be at home in the Nebraska prairies and looks forward to seeing them. “It will be like coming home – seeing the prairie landscape that I miss,” she said. “Victoria is city living.” She also related that she loves to wear blue jeans, at one time broke horses, and is a country girl at heart.

Pat will deliver an inspirational talk on Friday night centered on her theme, “Achieving Greatness Together” and how we can all take our own developmental journey. She is also playing a character in the Murder Mystery! On Saturday, she will deliver an educational session on achieving goals and Saturday evening at the banquet, she’ll share with us some of what nature can teach us.
