Parliamentary Procedure: When the Chair Can't Be There

When you are the chair of a meeting, there are certain guidelines for presiding over the meeting. You must open the meeting on time and make sure a guorum is present

You must follow an agreed-upon order to keep the meeting moving on schedule

You must make sure all members of the assembly (meeting) are heard

You must determine what the majority desires by vote and make sure all present are aware of the results

You must not let the discussions get derailed and maintain order of the assembly

You may vote because you are a member of the assembly-but there are restrictions.

You must carry out the wishes of the assembly and be impartial You must be present

It is this last item that I would like to focus on. What happens when you can't be there? If for any reason the chair is not there, who should take over? There are several choices. The next senior officer is the most likely person to run the meeting in the chair's absence. One of the quirks of the parliamentary rules is that the chair should not plan to be absent and appoint someone as a replacement –unless the group approves. So what happens if there is no chairperson and no other officer present? The secretary is appointed to take the lead and facilitate the election of a temporary chair. This same process is followed if the chairperson feels that they cannot be impartial or want to actively debate or discuss an issue.

This process does not apply to the District Parliamentarian. The District Parliamentarian serves at the discretion of the District Governor. As your outgoing District Parliamentarian (a member of the district who had the pleasure to learn how to use parliamentary procedure in district meetings), it is my honor to turn over my duties to Jonathan Gardner who will continue this effort in this new Toastmaster Year. **George Volz, DTM**

Toastmasters International is a world leader in communication and leadership development. Our membership is 270,000 strong. These members improve their speaking and leadership skills by attending one of the 13,000 clubs that make up our global network of meeting locations.

Toastmasters International is comprised of 14 regions which are further divided into nearly 90 Districts. District 24 is part of Region IV, which includes the U.S. states of Iowa, Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota and South Dakota as well as the Canadian provinces of Alberta, Ontario, Manitoba, and Saskatchewan. The boundary of District 24 is as follows: The State of Nebraska, less the western panhandle area, which starts at the western boundary of Keith County and follows north along the western boundaries of Arthur, Grant, and Cherry Counties ending at the South Dakota border, plus the western portion of Pottawattamie County, west of Highway 59, less Dakota County in Nebraska.

Membership in Toastmasters is one of the greatest investments you can make in yourself. At \$36 every six months, it is also one of the most cost-effective skill-building tools available anywhere.

How Does It Work?

A Toastmasters meeting is a learn-by-doing workshop in which participants hone their speaking and leadership skills in a no-pressure atmosphere.

There is no instructor in a Toastmasters meeting. Instead, members evaluate one another's presentations. This feedback process is a key part of the program's success.

Meeting participants also give impromptu talks on assigned topics, conduct meetings and develop skills related to timekeeping, grammar and parliamentary procedure.
